Amid speculations of rift with BJP, Nitish gives away JD(U) tickets

PRESS TRUST OF INDIA Patna, October 14

AMID INTENSE SPECULATIONS that the NDA seat-sharing deal has left him infuriated, Bihar Chief Minister Nitish Kumar on Tuesday gave away JD(U) tickets, bypassing the party's earlier practice of announcing the names of candidates at a press conference.

On the other hand, the BJP, which has been put on the same pedestal as the JD(U) for the first time in an assembly election, announced its first list of 71 candidates. Springing surprises, it denied a ticket to Speaker Nand Kishore Yadav, a seven-term MLA, while fielding Deputy CM Samrat Choudhary in a direct election after over a decade.

Health and Law Minister Mangal Pandey, a member of the legislative council, has also been fielded by the party for the assembly polls.

It was not immediately known how many JD(U) candidates were given tickets during the day, as the CM's residence kept bustling with activity, with aspirants turning up after receiving a call from the party chief.

However, prominent among those who did are minister Bijendra Prasad Yadav, state JD(U) president Umesh Singh Kushwaha (Mahnar) and gangster-turned-politician Anant Kumar Singh (Mokama). Many of them also



filed their nomination papers. There was some drama, too, as Gopalpur MLA Gopal Mandal, who is said to have angered Kumar by remaining in the news for all the wrong reasons, turned up at the CM's residence without seeking an appointment. When security personnel tried to prevent him from entering the restricted area, he sat on a dharna, only to be bundled away into a police vehicle hours later.

Mandal's constituency falls in the Bhagalpur district, where he is also known to have a running feud with local JD(U) MP Ajay Mandal, who sought to resign from the party around the same time, alleging that tickets were being given in his area without heeding to his advice.

In the meantime, rumours spread like wildfire that Kumar, who is known to dump allies and forge new coalitions at will, was angry that his party was not given the lion's share in the deal struck at Delhi on Sunday.

Leaders in his own party as well as alliance partners were on

their feet, trying their best to assert that all was well, lest the situation might be taken advantage of by their adversaries.

"The opposition is starting at a defeat. It is therefore spreading rumours of a rift in the NDA. Actually, it is the INDIA bloc which is on the brink of collapse," alleged JD(U) working president Sanjay Kumar Jha, who was present in the national capital while the negotiations were on.

Reports in a section of the media also claimed that Jha, a former BJP man, had received a tongue-lashing from Kumar. On cue, several NDA leaders from the state, including Union minister Chirag Paswan, a former bete noire of the JD(U) president who was away in Chandigarh, came out with social media posts asserting that the NDA was united under the leadership of the longest-serving CM.

Union minister Jitan Ram Manjhi, the only NDA partner to have gone public with his displeasure over getting only six seats, also asserted on social media that his own displeasure over a less-than-desired share must not result in the alliance coming apart.

Paswan's Lok Janshakti Party (Ram Vilas) has got 29 seats, despite not having a single MLA, while Rajya Sabha MP Upendra Kushwaha, whose Rashtriya Lok Morcha is just two years old, has got as many seats as Manjhi's Hindustani Awam Morcha (HAM).

India reliable partner in Mongolia's progress: PM

INDIA HAS BEEN a "reliable partner" in Mongolia's development and both the nations support a free, open and rules-based Indo-Pacific, Prime Minister Narendra Modi said on Tuesday after holding wide-ranging talks with Mongolian President Khurelsukh Ukhnaa.

Ukhnaa landed in New Delhi on Monday on a four-day visit to India, his first to the country as president.

Following his talks with the visiting leader, Modi said India will extend free e-visas to people from Mongolia.

"The oil refinery project, supported by India's \$1.7 billion line of credit, will strengthen Mongolia's energy security," the prime minister said.

It is India's largest development partnership project globally, with over 2,500 Indian professionals working alongside their Mongolian counterparts

to make it a reality, he said. "We stand as close partners in international forums, supporting a free, open, inclusive, and rules-based Indo-Pacific.

Together, we also work to amplify the voice of the Global South," Modi said.

On his part, the Mongolian president hailed India's leading role in the clean energy sector and specifically referred to the New Delhi-led International Solar Alliance.

In his media statement, Modi also noted that the engagement between India and Mongolia is more than just a diplomatic relationship.

"It is a deep, soulful, and spiritual bond. The depth and scope of our partnership is reflected in our people-to-people ties," he said.

"Both our countries share the age-old bond of Buddhism, which is why we are also called spiritual siblings," he added.

The prime minister said several important decisions were

taken in the talks he had with Ukhnaa to further strengthen this tradition and historic ties between the two nations.

"I am happy to announce that next year, the holy relics of two great disciples of Lord Buddha - Sariputra and Maudgalyayana - will be sent from India to Mongolia," Modi said.

India will also send a Sanskrit teacher to Gandan Monastery to support in-depth study of Buddhist texts and continue the ancient tradition of knowledge, he said.

"We have decided to soon launch a project to digitise one million ancient manuscripts. Nalanda University has played a vital role in Buddhism in Mongolia, and today we have agreed to strengthen this historic connection by linking Nalanda with Gandan Monastery," he said.

India mulls joint reconstruction effort for Gaza

WITH MINISTER OF State for External Affairs Kirti Vardhan Singh representing the country at the Sharm el-Sheikh peace summit on Gaza, India is looking to send relief material as humanitarian assistance to the people of Gaza in the coming days and weeks. It is also considering contributing to the rebuilding of Gaza.

Delhi's immediate effort, it is learnt, will be to send humanitarian assistance in the form of medicines, food, tents, blankets, women's san-

itary items, baby formula for the people of Gaza.

The next step will be to clear the rubble in the enclave and help in rebuilding water systems and sanitation works, destroyed in Israeli air strikes and shelling.

The US estimates that around \$70 billion is needed to rebuild Gaza, and that about 83% of all building structures in Gaza City have been destroyed.

A UN official told the Reuters news agency that the two-year war in Gaza in which about 68,000 people have died - it followed the Hamas

attack on Israel on October 7, 2023 in which 1,200 people were killed and 250 taken hostage - had produced rubble equal to 13 times the material that went into building the pyramids of Giza.

Jaco Cilliers, an official at the United Nations Development Programme, said Israel's war against Hamas generated at least 55 million tonnes of rubble and that it could take decades for Gaza to recover fully.

The UNDP said it had already cleared some 81,000 tonnes of rubble from the Gaza Strip and was continu-

ing to do so.

Given the precarious situation in Gaza where a ceasefire has just come into effect, Delhi is keeping a close watch on the next steps - from the security arrangements in the form of the International Stabilisation Force, the disarming and demilitarisation of Hamas, and the governance structure via the Board of Peace to be led by US President Donald Trump with former British Prime Minister Tony Blair in it too.

The Palestinians, including Hamas, have indicated that they will hand over their

arms to a Palestinian governance structure. There is a debate on whether only big arms equipment have to be deposited and small arms can be retained for safety given the ongoing clashes between rivals in Gaza.

On Tuesday, the Ministry of External Affairs said, "India stands for peace in the Middle East and resolution of issues through dialogue and diplomacy. We support the Gaza peace plan of President Trump and appreciate Egypt and Qatar for their valuable roles in achieving this and advancing the path to peace."

Biocon chief flags Bengaluru infra woes; Shivakumar urges collective effort

BIOCON CHIEF KIRAN Mazumdar-Shaw has reignited the debate over Bengaluru's infrastructure by sharing a visiting overseas executive's critical comments on the city's roads and garbage, prompting Deputy Chief Minister DK Shivakumar to say the city deserves collective effort, not constant criticism.

State Ministers Priyank Kharge and M B Patil also acknowledged the problems and said fixing them would require time.

They called for "collective effort" to improve the city.

Talking to 'X' to highlight the city's infrastructure problems, Shaw said, "I had an overseas business visitor to Biocon Park who said, 'Why are the

roads so bad, and why is there so much garbage around?'"

Doesn't the Govt want to support investment? I have just come from China and can't understand why India can't get its act together, especially when the winds are favourable?"

She tagged CM Siddaramaiah, DK Shivakumar, and IT/BT Minister Priyank Kharge.

The state government has come under criticism over the poor state of roads and traffic issues in the city.

Shivakumar, who is also the minister in charge of Bengaluru development, without making any reference to Shaw's post, said Bengaluru has given opportunities, identity, and success to millions - it deserves collective effort, not constant criticism.
